

RESOLUTION 1977-78-1

WHEREAS, the Port of Hood River is the owner and the operator of the Hood River Airport, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the safety and effective operation of the airport that there be adequate open air space free of obstructions in or about the airport for the free and clear approach of airplanes, that these clearances must be obtained in order to continue operation of the airport, and

WHEREAS, GLEN W. MARSH, JR. and PAULINE MARSH, husband and wife, are the owners of real property in the county of Hood River, State of Oregon, which lies adjacent to the East boundary line of the airport and is within the approach area from the East and can be an obstruction to the safe approach to the airport which property is described as follows:

The South one-half of the Southeast one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter of Section 11, Township 2 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the operation of the airport that said property be acquired,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED for the reasons above stated that it is necessary and proper that the Port of Hood River obtain title to the above described real property and the staff is hereby directed to negotiate with GLEN W. MARSH, Jr. and PAULINE MARSH, husband and wife, for the purchase of said property, subject to the approval of the commission in all details.
