

**PORT OF HOOD RIVER
Resolution No. 2005-06-7**

**Authorization to Apply for a Transportation Enhancement Grant for
Development of Riverfront Pedestrian Trail System**

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation is accepting applications for a Transportation Enhancement Grant, and;

WHEREAS, the Port of Hood River desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing a waterfront bicycle and pedestrian trail system that connects to other pathways on the waterfront and into the City of Hood River, and;

WHEREAS, the Port of Hood River Commission has identified public trail routes and improvements on its waterfront properties, and;

WHEREAS, the Port of Hood River has requested additional federal funding assistance for this project in the amount of \$500,000, and that the project can be accomplished in phases dependent upon the amount of federal funds awarded; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Hood River certifies that it is committed and capable of completing this project, either fully or in phases; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Hood River certifies that its matching share percentage of 20% for this project is available for the proposed waterfront trail system and is identified in the current budget and 5-year capital plan;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Port of Hood River be authorized to apply for a Transportation Enhancement Grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for a public bicycle and pedestrian trail system on Port of Hood River property located on the waterfront.
