RESOLUTION NO. 1987-1988-7

RESOLUTION OF THE PORT OF HOOD RIVER , COUNTY OF HOOD RIVER,
STATE OF OREGON, AUTHORIZING A JOINT APPLICATION WITH THE
PORT OF CASCADE LOCKS FOR A GRANT FROM THE PORT PLANNING AND
MARKETING GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the 1988 session of the Oregon Legislature created a Port
Planning and Marketing Fund to improve the port's capability to carry
out functions and activities relating to economic diversification, or
the development of a new or emerging industry; and

WHEREAS, the legislation has directed the Ports Division to give
priority to regional or cooperative projects; and

WHEREAS, the Ports of Cascade Locks and Hood River have determined
that the increase in windsurfing as a recreational sport in the
Columbia Gorge is an emerging tourist related industry; and

WHEREAS, the sponsorship of a major windsurfing event, hereinafter
known as the Columbia Gorge Cities Series by the two ports will aid in
the development of this emerging industry;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Port of Hood River
Commission will join with the Port of Cascade Locks to jointly apply
for a grant from the Port Planning and Marketing Fund to aid in the
sponsorship of the Columbia Gorge Cities Series.
