RESOLUTION NO. 1986-87-2 (Emergency - Waucoma Center)

BE IT RESOLVED by the PORT OF HOOD RIVER that:

- 1. An emergency is declared to exist as a result of the Waucoma Center fire on August 28, 1986.
- 2. It is necessary to take immediate action to repair the damage caused by the fire because:
 - A. The fire marshall has declared a hazard exists due to fire debris, and flammable and smoldering materials, and has ordered the Port to correct the condition.
 - B. The fire damage is hindering the general contractor in performance of its contract.
 - C. The roof must be repaired to protect the building from rain damage.
 - D. United Telephone Company wishes to construct its tenant improvements and the Port wishes to begin receiving rent as soon as possible, according to the terms of the parties' lease.
- 3. Pursuant to public contract rule 125-310-030, and for the reasons stated above, the Port hereby waives all formal competitive bid requirements for public contracts to

repair damage and correct problems resulting from the Waucoma Center fire.
