

RESOLUTION #1985-86-5

RESOLUTION OF THE PORT HOOD RIVER, HOOD RIVER COUNTY, STATE OF OREGON, AUTHORIZING A JOINT APPLICATION WITH THE PORT OF THE DALLES AND CASCADE LOCKS FOR A GRANT FROM THE PORT PLANNING AND MARKETING GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the 1985 session of the Oregon Legislature created a Port Planning and Marketing Fund to improve the port's capability to carry out functions and activities relating to economic diversification, or the development of a new or emerging industry; and

WHEREAS, the Ports of The Dalles, Hood River and Cascade Locks have determined that the increase in windsurfing as a recreational sport in the Columbia Gorge is an emerging tourist related industry; and

WHEREAS, the sponsorship of a major windsurfing event, hereinafter known as the Columbia Gorge Cities Series by the three ports will aid in the development of this emerging industry;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that The Port of Hood River Board of Commission will join with the Ports of Cascade Locks and The Dalles to jointly apply for a grant from the Port Planning and Marketing Fund to aid in the sponsorship of the Columbia Gorge Cities Series.
