## **RESOLUTION 1993-94-3**

A RESOLUTION OF THE PORT OF HOOD RIVER, HOOD RIVER COUNTY, OREGON, AUTHORIZING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS AND COOPERATIVE ARRANGEMENTS AMONG GOVERNMENTAL BODIES IN HOOD RIVER COUNTY.

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the above named organization to create a general mechanism for discussions with other governmental entities for cost efficient intergovernmental arrangements;

WHEREAS, intergovernmental arrangements may be in the interest of governmental entities when general, cost-effective prerequisites are met;

WHEREAS, cost effective prerequisites may include, but are not limited to the following:

- reduction of costs of services, materials, or capital investments;
- prevention of growth in duplicative duties, services, or resources;
- 3. share or centralize purchasing of certain items; and
- D. share equipment inventories and personnel services,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Port of Hood River Commission hereby authorizes its administrative staff to begin discussion with other governmental entities in the pursuit of intergovernmental arrangements which may meet certain cost effective criteria, and in appropriate circumstances to enter into arrangements and agreements with other governmental entities which meet, in whole or in part, the above prerequisites.
