Mr. Fran Roberts of Aero Spray Inc., advised the committee that except afor times when Mr. Wright (The Farmer leasing land from airport) was irrigating that there was no water, Apparently Mr. Wright is paying the electric bill for operation of a pump, and when not personally using, He shuts it off, therefo no water is available except at the administration building. There are outlets but no water since pump is shut off.
Motion was made by Glen McPherrin and 2nd by Ted Ekker,

" That The County Make study and provision for water for Aero Spray Inc, and other users who might need it. At least make provision for pump to be operative."

3. Bob Meyers Reports --- 1. That Activity has picked up since His arrival and He expects it to more and more as word spreads that someone is there. He has painted Thresholds and Runway Numbers, The first We have had there. The airport needs some growth , such as facility for Forrest Service who wishes to come back, Runway Extention as recommended in 1 and 2 of State He has been in contact with Forrest Service -- They stated they had moved because could get no service here --- The Dalles bends over backwards for them --- They would rather be here as closer to operation if just could get soem cooperation from us. Need office space extension. 5-30-7 Also reported complaint from Mr, Andrews about noise

4. At 9:00 P.M. went to planning commission meeting and requested they recomend to County Commission as in subject I above. After some discussion, they voted to so recomend.

There was general discussion that KPKEKEKEK apparently the importance of the aipport facility is not realized where it counts. Hood River Valley is primarily supported by Agriculture and Forest products, but they are least considered where the airport is concerned. Spray operations add forest surveilance is done almost exclusively by aircraft, and the need for improvement is great. It was brought out several times that the airport appears to be in run down condition and repeated requests for care by the County have been substantially ignored. - 1. That The county Road department or responsible department be directed to put the Airport on it's schedule as part of the normal routine maintenance, since nothing happens on a hit or miss basis, and the field is in generally run down, more or less ignored condition.
- 2. A potentially dengerous condition exists in that it is reported that at night there is so e use of the landing area being used by motorcy cles MIXATIME. which if there when plans is landing would be very corious. It is recommended that the back read into airport be closed off, or some method of control be found to stop this.
