RESOLUTION NO. 1989-90-4 (Declaration of Intent to Acquire Property)

WHEREAS, under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oregon, the Port of Hood River ("Port") is authorized to acquire property and interests in property when necessary or convenient in carrying out its powers; and,

WHEREAS, in furtherance of planned development of Port property, in the public's interest, the Port intends to alter an existing bay and utilize Port property, as authorized under Chapter 777 of Oregon Revised Statutes, now,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Port of Hood River does hereby find and declare that it is necessary that the Port acquire the real property and the interests therein described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein, in order to change wharf lines and make improvements to an existing bay, and so that Port property together with the property described in Exhibit "A" can be utilized in accordance with a comprehensive plan, in a manner consistent with the Port's commercial interests and the public's convenience.
- 2. The use and improvement of Port property for which the real property and interests therein described in Exhibit "A" is required and is being taken, as necessary in the public interest, is most compatible with the greatest public benefit compared to private damage.
- 3. The Port and its attorneys are hereby authorized to attempt to agree with the owners and other persons in interest in the real property and interests therein described in Exhibit "A" as to the compensation to be paid for the appropriation of the property, and, in the event that no satisfactory agreement can be reached, then the attorneys for the Port are directed and authorized to commence and prosecute to final determination such proceedings as may be necessary to acquire the real property and interests therein and upon the filing of such proceeding, possession of the real property and interests therein may be taken immediately.
- 4. Upon the trial or any action instituted to acquire the real property or any interests therein, the attorneys acting on behalf of the Port are hereby authorized to make such stipulation, agreement or admission as in their judgment may be in the best interests of the Port.

- 5. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public, an emergency exists and it is necessary that no undue delay be encountered in obtaining access to and possession of the real property and interests therein described in Exhibit "A", in order for the Port to receive fill material from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Bonneville Dam locks project, and therefore this resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Port Commission.
- 6. This Resolution is passed and adopted by the Commissioners of the Port of Hood River, on this 29th day of January 1990.
