



Aviation Technology and Emergency Response Center (ATERRC) Clarification #3

Issued: Friday, January 31, 2020

- 1. An Addendum #2 will be issued next week, no later than February 5th.**
- 2. Bid Item 48 Irrigation System – Lump Sum – includes what? Please clarify. This bid item includes all labor, equipment and material to complete the installation of the Farmer's Irrigation system improvements, including connection of the main lines and services to the existing system. Note that the pipe material, fittings and valves are either onsite or will be provided onsite prior to construction. It is anticipated that the contractor supplied materials will be limited to trench backfill and any supplies needed to execute the installation of the owner-supplied materials. Note that any items for which a separate bid item exists are not to be included within the Irrigation System bid item.**
- 3. Sheet 11 shows Concrete Fueling Pad – what bid item is this part of? Bid Item 57: Fueling Pad. The Fuel Tank Pad is paid under Bid Item 58: New Aircraft Fueling System.**
- 4. Will the contractor have to pull any County permits for the sewer tie in on Tucker Road? It is not anticipated that County permits will be required to complete this work. The required ODOT permit has been obtained and is included as part of the bid documents.**
- 5. ODOT permit appears to show different alignment for the sewer connection (sheet C4.1 in the ODOT permit set shows connecting to the existing manhole). Is the permit current? How is the 8" asphalt trench patch and 1.5" asphalt overlay-lay paid for in the trench restoration of Tucker Road, what bid item? The permit is approved based on the side sewer connection currently shown in the plans. The engineer will attempt to get a current version of the permit to reflect this prior to bid opening, however, this is not guaranteed. Any paving is to be paid per the Level 4, ½" ACP bid item.**
- 6. Please clarify if compaction testing is to be covered in the contractor's bid? Compaction testing shall be provided by the contractor and included in the contractor's bid.**
